****Was** is used with the pronouns *I, she, he, it, someone, anyone, nobody* and *no one*. Important note: it is often forgotten that we use was also with the pronoun everyone:

-Correct: Everyone was happy with the result.

-Mistake: Everyone were happy with the result.

****Were** is used with all other pronouns- I, you, we and they.

US vs British forms

In British English, the past forms of **dream** are **dreamt** and **dreamt** (both /*dremt*/). Speakers of US English sometimes use **dreamt** and **dreamt** as the past forms of dream, but they also sometimes employ dream as a regular verb with the forms **dreamed** and **dreamed**.

In British English, the forms of **learn** are **learnt** and **learnt**. Speakers of US English however use learn as a regular verb with the forms learned and learned.

In British English **shine** is an irregular verb with the forms **shone** and **shone**. In US English **shine** may be used as an irregular verb with the same forms **shone** and **shone**, or as a regular verb with the forms **shined** and **shined**.

The second form of **show** is **showed**, and the preferred third form is **shown**, although **showed** is also acceptable.
